FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 12 foot side yard requirement for an attached garage are as follows:

- a) The existing dwelling is located well toward the rear of the lot in excess of the minimum front yard requirement. The result is limited rear yard area.
- b) Options for placement of a garage to the left or to the rear are precluded by a concrete porch on the left and the well in the rear.
- c) The property is located on a private street and the 30 foot street shown on the survey is apparently not intended for development.
- d) The attached garage will replace an existing carport and intended for storage of a motor home as well as personal vehicles.
