FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a 50 foot front and side yard requirement for a porch enclosure and attached garage are as follows:

- a) The front and side property lines of this property have large established trees which buffer it from adjoining properties.
- b) The property line opposite the proposed garage addition abuts an airport runway.
- c) Other residences in the area will not be adversely affected by the enclosure and additions.
