HEARING HELD: July 2, 1997


FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a variance reducing the minimum lot size requirement for a private stable are as follows:

- a. Lot 1 in this subdivision previously was granted a variance to lot areas for horses.
- b. This minimal reduction in the lot area requirements would have no adverse affect on adjoining properties.
- c. There are no unusual characteristics to this lot that would prevent this stable in meeting the distance requirements of section 4.12.
