Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.


Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, a reduction in the minimum rear yard requirement for a deck, are as follows:

The deck in this case has already been constructed. This is a ground level deck coming off the rear of the house and is not visible by any adjoining property. The parcel on which this dwelling is located is at the end of a use in common driveway which enters off of a cul-de-sac. The property is surrounded by large established trees which buffer the dwelling from other properties.

Approval of this (10) ten foot variance will have no adverse affect on adjoining properties.
