FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 5 foot side yard requirement for accessory buildings in the rear yard are as follows:

- a) The existing buildings were constructed in 1980, 1981, and 1987 without permits and have been unchallenged until now.
- b) Applicant testified that he was unaware of permit requirements.
- c) The property line remains in some question. The buildings may comply.

Approval of this variance is subject to the following condition(s):

- Applicant must secure the required permit(s).
- 2) No additional accessory buildings will be approved except to replace or to combine the existing buildings.
