## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that the use of the premises is severely restricted by the combination of the recorded minimum building line, siting of the dwelling, location of the water supply well, and the water supply line from the well to the dwelling. In addition, location of the detached garage is architecturally compatible with the dwelling only as proposed, and there is no indication that establishment of the garage, not closer than ten feet to the adjacent side property line and outside of the drainage and utility easement which is 10 feet in width, will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
