FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that the property is zoned "A" Agricultural District, which requires a minimum lot area of one acre for residential purposes; the lot as it existed prior to August 6, 1987, contained 1.92 acres, which precluded its division into two residential lots; the area of the lot was enlarged by deed to 2.71 acres August 6, 1987, in order to comply with the minimum lot area requirements to permit division of the property into two lots for residential purposes; relaxation of the minimum lot area requirements by .08 of an acre will facilitate pursuit of present farming activities; and, there is no indication that the authorization as requested will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
