## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The pertinent findings dictating denial include the facts that no evidence was introduced warranting reduction of the minimum required side yard to one foot as proposed; enlargement of the dwelling to within one foot of the side property line would unduly affect the adjoining residential property, and tend to depreciate the property values; and, authorization of the request would be contrary to the intent and purpose of the zoning ordinance. Accordingly, the Board must, and hereby, deny the request.
