Based on the application, testimony and eyidence comprising the record of this case, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that use of the property is restricted by its configuration, and necessity to protect the replacement area for the sewerage disposal system. Location of the garage other than as proposed would require the removal of number of valuable hardwood trees that are beneficial to the lot and to the adjoining properties. In addition, there is no indication that establishment of the attached garage as proposed will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
