## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that establishment of the minimum building setback line of 95 feet from Surrey Court was apparently to provide an area for replacement of the on-site sewerage disposal system, if necessary; relaxation of the minimum building restriction line to about 72 feet to allow construction of the proposed garage should not substantially affect the area reserved for replacement systems; the reduced minimum building line will exceed the minimum requirement of 60 feet for the "R-40,000" Residence District; and, there is no indication that construction of the attached garage will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
