The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the minimum building line of 90 feet established by the recorded plat exceeds the minimum required front yard of 40 feet specified in Article 6A, Section 6A.5 of Ordinance 1E for the "T" Transitional District; only a portion of the proposed three car garage will encroach beyond the minimum building line of 90 feet; and, there is no indication that establishment of the attached garage will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
