The findings in that case include the facts that the 1.5 acre property is located adjacent to the City of Westminster and will be served with public water and sanitary sewerage facilities. Vehicular access will be from Liberty Street and is subject to the requirements of the Engineering Access Permits Division of the State Highway Administration. Subdivision of the property into four lots for the development of the two semidetached dwellings is reasonable and appropriate for the property; and, there is no indication that the proposed use will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
