FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board hereby approves approximately 30 square feet of additional sign area in excess of the allowable sign area of 275 square feet, for a total of about 305 square feet. During the public hearing it was established that the allowable sign area, based on the frontage of the building, is 220 square feet, and that the property is a corner lot and is entitled to an additional 25 percent of sign area. Accordingly, the allowable sign area is 275 square feet (220 square feet + 55 square feet = 275 square feet). In addition, the Board hereby confirms and approves the location of the existing freestanding sign on the premises. The purpose of the confirmation and approval is to remove any doubt as to whether or not the sign conforms to the location requirements of the zoning ordinance. In authorizing these variances, the Board finds no indication that the additional sign area and location of the freestanding sign will unduly affect the use of adjacent properties, the values of those properties, or the public interests.
