The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board approved the request. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the existing distribution center will continue to be the principal use of the property; the sales shop, specializing in company products, will replace a smaller existing employees store and will be open to the public; although the sales shop is anticipated to generate additional vehicular traffic to the premises, the existing parking facilities will be enlarged to comply with the requirements of the zoning ordinance; the sales shop will be incidental to and compliment operation of the existing distribution center; and, no evidence was introduced which would indicate that establishment of the sales shop, as proposed, will unduly affect the use or value of adjacent properties, or the public interests.
