FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The appeal, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board affirmed the appeal to allow the proposed detached accessory building of 30 feet by 50 feet to be erected on the property, subject to the condition that the building shall not be used for any commercial purpose. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that detached accessory buildings as large as 30 feet by 40 feet are customarily permitted by the zoning administrator. In this case, by increasing the the additional length of the building to 50 feet Mr. Sellers will be able to use the building for customary and incidental purposes, as well as his avocation of pitching horseshoes without unduly affecting the residents of adjacent homes, the values of their homes, or the public interests.
