## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board approved the conditional use as requested. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the conditional use for the commercial sports arena was authorized September 11, 1992 in Case 3781; since that time the arena has been established and has been operating without adversely affecting either residents of nearby homes, the values of those homes, or nearby businesses; the additional activities and events will be incidental and subordinate to the principal use of the property as a commercial sports arena; the location and facilities of the arena are particularly appropriate for the proposed events and activities; there is no indication that such events and activities will have any undue adverse effects; and, use of the arena for the proposed events and activities will be in accord with the purpose of the zoning ordinance and the good interest of the public.
