FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, and in accordance with the state Open Meetings Act, the Board approved the conditional use and variances necessary for the establishment of a one chair beauty shop within the dwelling, except that as discussed and agreed to during the public hearing, the beauty shop is authorized as an accessory use in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.4(b) instead of Sections 6.3(c) and 6.7 of the zoning ordinance. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the dwelling will continue to be the principal use of the property; establishment of the one chair beauty shop within the dwelling will not alter its residential characteristics; if the proposed addition to the dwelling would have been solely for residential purposes, no variances would be required; and, there is no evidence that establishment of the one chair beauty shop, as proposed and operated solely by a resident, will unduly affect residents of adjacent properties, the values of those properties, or public interests.
