FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record and in accordance with the state Open Meetings Act, the Board approved the conditional use, subject to the Zoning Administrator reviewing the site plan concerning onsite parking requirements. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that the cemetery is a nonconforming use, established in 1956. The chapel and a garden building will be constructed first. The storage facility is appropriate and will be incidental to maintenance and operation of the cemetery and mausoleum. The remaining garden buildings may be completed in twelve to fifteen years. Therefore, the Board waives the time limit to apply for the requisite zoning certificates. Furthermore, there is no indication that establishment of the mausoleum and storage facility, as proposed and in compliance with applicable laws, will unduly affect residents or values of adjacent properties, or public interests.
