FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

No complaints have been received from any neighbors. These dogs are personal pets only and the Applicant has no intention of boarding or selling dogs.

The Board finds that the proposed use at this location will not generate adverse effects at this location above and beyond those normally associated with such a use. Accordingly, the conditional use request is granted.
