FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

On August 28, 2002, the Board of Zoning Appeals (the Board) convened to hear the request for a kennel for less than ten (10) dogs. Based on the testimony and evidence presented, the Board made the following findings and conclusion:

The Applicant currently owns three dogs, which are housed on the Applicant's 21 acres (+-) of agricultural property. The Applicant's daughter wishes to bring home an additional three pet dogs, thereby necessitating the request for a "kennel", as it is defined in the Zoning Law. The area is fenced and the nearest neighbor is ¼ mile away.

The Board finds that the proposed use at this location will not generate adverse effects above and beyond those normally associated with such a use. Accordingly, a conditional use for a kennel for less than 10 dogs is granted.
