FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The applicant raises buffalo on his property at the referenced address. He is seeking permission to sell buffalo meat from his herd in an existing small barn on the site. No butchering will occur on the premises. He also wants to sell vegetables and farm products at the stand. Initial hours of operation will be Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.

The Board finds that the proposed use at this location will not generate adverse effects above and beyond those normally associated with such a use. In addition, the use is appropriate and will benefit the Lineboro area and promote agriculture. Accordingly, the request for a conditional use is granted with the condition that the Applicant submits a simplified site plan to the Bureau of Development Review.
