FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The subject property is a long, narrow 2.033 acre lot. The septic field is located in the front of the house. There is an existing garage on one side of the house.

The Applicants wish to improve their property with a sunroom. Due to the location of the garage, septic field and the unusual configuration of the lot, there is no other feasible location for the proposed sunroom. Accordingly, the Board finds that the requisite hardship has been proven, and the grant of the variance as requested above is warranted.
