## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

On August 30, 2011, the Board of Zoning Appeals (the Board) convened to hear the request for an accessory use for a day care center not exceeding 6,000 sq. ft. Based on the testimony and evidence presented, the Board made the following findings and conclusion:

The subject property is a 2,700 square foot suite in a strip center. The strip center includes offices and a dance studio. The Applicant wishes to open a day care center in the suite. The day care center will open with approximately 15 students and 2 employees. It could grow to as many as 40 students. The students will be picked up after school by a company van and dropped off at the center. Parents will retrieve the children at staggered times in the afternoon. Ample parking exists in the strip center. The suite will be improved with equipment and materials for the day care operation. In addition, there is space in the rear lot of the center available for their use.

Day care centers of less than 6,000 square feet may be approved by the Board as accessory uses in this zone. In this case, the Board found that a day care center of this size is a valid accessory use to the strip center and the request was granted.
