## **FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS**

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing the accessory use is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, an accessory use for a welding shop for a home occupation are as follows:

The applicant proposes to use his garage for a home occupation for a welding shop to do decorative welding such as fencing, art work and other welding activities. He plans on using 500 feet of the detached garage for the shop. The garage sits behind the house and all work is proposed to be in the garage. Mr. Sliviak's neighbors sent numerous letters in support of his activities.

No neighbors were present at the hearing opposing the accessory use; therefore, the granting of this accessory use should have no adverse effect on any adjoining property owners.

This approval is valid for one year from the date of this decision.

Note: An appeal of a Decision made pursuant to Chapter 223-181.2 may be made to the Board of Zoning Appeals within thirty (30) days of the date of the Zoning Administrator's decision in accordance with Chapter 223-182 and 223-188 of the Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances.

A decision of the Zoning Administrator made pursuant to Chapter 223-181 is final and constitutes a zoning action. Unless timely appealed, parties may not thereafter challenge the Zoning Administrator's decision.
