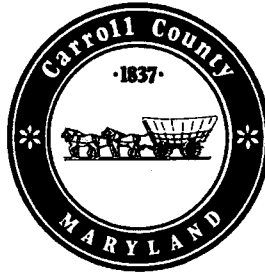

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing the accessory use is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, an accessory use for a professional office within in a residence is as follows: The applicant would like to run a consulting practice from his home. There is plenty of parking area for clients and he does not foresee having more than 6 clients at the property per day. The residence is a parsonage of a church which he is renting.

No neighbors were present at the hearing opposing the accessory use; therefore, the granting of this accessory use should have no adverse effect on any adjoining property owners.

This approval is valid for one year from the date of this decision.

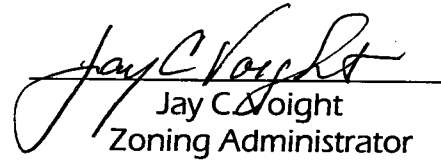
CARROLL COUNTY
