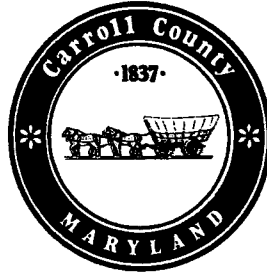

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing the accessory use is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance; in this case, a daycare for 8 or less children , are as follows:

Mrs. Trieschman has applied for an approval to provide daycare for 8 or less children. There is an ongoing need for daycare in Carroll County. Mrs. Treishman owns a large lot with enough room for children to play.

No neighbors were present at the hearing opposing the accessory use; therefore, the granting of this accessory use should have no adverse effect on any adjoining property owners.

This approval is valid for one year from the date of this decision.
