REQUEST: A variance reducing the minimum rear yard requirement from 35 feet to about 23 feet for a partially screened deck.

LOCATION: 1694 King Richard Road, in E.D. 5, lot 228, in Section 3B of Ryland at Carrolltowne, a subdivision recorded at 30/53.

APPLICABLE REGULATIONS: Art. 14, Div. VIII, Sec. 14.8(j); Art.15, Sec. 15.3 & 15.5

HEARING HELD: May 3, 1995

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 35 foot rear yard requirement for a partially screened deck are as follows:

- a) The rear portion of this lot slopes severely. In fact, the back yard space is restricted by a retaining wall constructed to correct an erosion and drainage problem.
- b) The deck will afford usable outdoor space not presently available.
- c) The other properties in line are similarly improved.
