REQUEST: A variance reducing the minimum rear yard requirement from  
26.25 feet to about 23 feet for an open deck.

LOCATION: 6351 Georgetown Blvd., in E.D. 5, Lot 30, in Section 1 of  
Hunters Crossing, a subdivision recorded at 36/81.

APPLICABLE REGULATIONS: Art. 14, Sec. 14.8(j); Art. 15, Sec. 15.5;

HEARING HELD: September 6, 1995

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the  
variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the  
ordinance, in this case a 26.25 foot rear yard requirement for an open deck  
are as follows:

- a) The usable yard is severley affected by a steep slope.
- b) The area of the deck protruding into the yard requirement  
is only 2'x12'.
- c) There is no dwelling proposed to be located directly behind this  
lot.
