FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 35 foot rear yard requirement for a residence are as follows:

- a) The lot area is at the minimum for the zone and the buildable area is very restrictive. The area is developed with 2 story homes, relatively deep for their width. This design offers a mix of house styles.
- b) To reduce the depth of the garage or the adjoining area of the dwelling would affect construction details and result in impractical configuration of the spaces.
