## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a reduction of the side yard requirement for a detached carport are as follows:

- a) The applicants residence sets back from Buckhorn Road on a shared driveway and the residence on the adjacent property sets some distance behind the applicants.
- b) The property line where the variance is requested is lined with existing established trees and some recently planted pines.
- c) Other residences in the area and the adjacent residence will not be adversely affected by the placement of the carport.
