FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is denied.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a variance increasing the maximum allowable square footage for a sign are as follows:

- a. No practical difficulty or undue hardship was proven by the applicant for the variance.
- b. It is the Zoning Administrator's position that in residential neighborhoods where signs are allowed in conjunction with home occupations that a 1x2 foot sign or 3 square feet is sufficient.
- c. If the applicant can reduce the existing sign configuration to 3 square feet it would make this decision moot, and abate the zoning violation related to the sign.
