HEARING HELD: August 6, 1997


FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a variance reducing the minimum distance requirement from property lines and adjacent dwellings for a stable are as follows:

- a. The dwelling to which the variance is required is screened entirely by a stand of older trees which run the entire property line therein screening the stable building from the dwelling.
- b. Placement of the stable on this property will have no adverse affect on adjoining properties.
