HEARING HELD: September 3, 1997


FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case a variance reducing the minimum side yard requirements for an addition are as follows:

- a. Prior to settlement and purchase of the property by the applicants who are now the current owners, the previous owner put an addition on the building. It is that addition that this variance was sought for.
- b. When the addition was built it was assumed the fence around the property was the property line. The fence in fact is (8) eight feet inside the property line on the adjoining property. Therefore when the addition was completed it was 12 feet from the side property line and not the required 20 feet.
- c. The addition to the building and its type of use will have no adverse affect on properties in this industrial park.
