FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, a reduction of the minimum side yard requirement for an addition, are as follows:

This property is located at the end of a use in common driveway that ends abruptly and lacks any cul-de-sac attributes for turning around to exit.

The construction of the addition will have no adverse affect on any adjoining property. The applicant in constructing a large blacktop parking pad in front of the addition will eliminate some of the parking and access problems that have existed with this property and the adjoining lot. The applicant is directed to ensure that the 30 foot right of way will not be encroached.
