## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 60 foot front yard requirement for enlargement of an attached garage are as follows:

- a) The existing dwelling sits at an angle. The proposed addition encroaches into the setback only at one corner, a maximum of seven (7) ft. tapering to nothing.
- b) The recorded setback exceeds the minimum front yard required by the Zoning Ordinance.
