REQUEST: A variance reducing the minimum required rear yard  
from 40 feet to about 22 feet for an addition.

LOCATION: 3320 Wilhelm Lane in Election District 6.

APPLICABLE REGULATIONS: Article 8, Section 8.5., Article 15,  
Section 15.5.

HEARING HELD: August 23, 1993

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing,  
the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict  
terms of the ordinance, in this case a 40 foot rear yard  
requirement for an addition to the residence, are as follows:

- a) The location of the dwelling at the extreme rear corner of the  
lot makes compliance with the rear yard requirement impossible  
for the proposed addition.
- b) However, location of the proposed addition in any other  
direction is precluded by the location of the well and the  
septic lines in front, the location of a swimming pool to the  
right of the dwelling, and the limited yard area to the left.
