## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 40 foot rear yard requirement for an addition to the residence, are as follows:

- a) The location of the dwelling at the extreme rear corner of the lot makes compliance with the rear yard requirement impossible for the proposed addition.
- b) However, location of the proposed addition in any other direction is precluded by the location of the well and the septic lines in front, the location of a swimming pool to the right of the dwelling, and the limited yard area to the left.
