FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the ordinance, in this case a 3 acre lot area requirement for a private stable are as follows:

a) The existing barn was constructed prior to the adoption of the Zoning Ordinance in 1965; and animals were housed there until approximately 1988 as a legal nonconforming use. This proceeding is only necessitated because the use had lapsed for more than six (6) months.

Approval of this variance is subject to the following condition(s):

- 1.) No increase in barn space is authorized.
- 2.) Existing screening and fencing is to be maintained to minimize the effect of the private stable on neighboring properties.

3.) Animal waste is to be managed so as to minimize odors and other concerns.
