HEARING HELD: October 6, 1993


FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing,
the variance is granted.

Facts which support the request for relief from the strict
terms of the ordinance, in this case a 20 ft. yard requirement for
an attached garage, are as follows:

- a) Location of a detached garage to the north side or to the rear
would be severely restricted by topography and by the location
of the septic system.
- b) The attached garage, as proposed, is architecturally
compatible with the design of the living space within the
dwelling.
