FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts, which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, a reduction of the minimum required setback of 20 feet to 17 feet for the construction of an attached garage to the existing dwelling, are as follows:

The property owners wish to convert their existing attached garage into a family room and construct a new attached garage the same width as the current one, due to the number and size of their vehicles. There is a retaining wall to the right of the house and grading is needed, but there should be no danger of runoff onto adjoining properties.

No neighbors were present at the hearing opposing the Applicant's request; therefore, the granting of this variance should have no adverse effect on any adjoining property owners.

This approval is valid for one year from the date of a Zoning Certificate.
