## FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the variance is granted.

Facts, which support the request for relief from the strict terms of the Ordinance, in this case, a reduction of the minimum required setback of 12 feet to 4 feet for the construction of an attached garage to the existing dwelling, are as follows:

The Applicant wishes to construct an attached garage on the left side of the house, which is where the driveway and existing carport are located. To reduce the size of the garage would not allow parking of two vehicles. The lot is narrow with the house in the center making it difficult to meet the setbacks for a two-car garage.

No neighbors were present at the hearing opposing the Applicant's request; therefore, the granting of this variance should have no adverse effect on any adjoining property owners.

This approval is valid for one year from the date of a Zoning Certificate.
