## FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

Based on the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing for this variance and a site visit for a physical review of the conditions, this variance is granted.

The property was inspected by the Zoning Administrator and the proposed enclosure of the existing masonry deck was found to have a minimal, if any effect on adjoining property owners and the overall character of the neighborhood.

The property was duly posted and adjoining property owners were notified of the variance hearing. The petitioner, Patio Enclosures, Inc., attended the hearing.

Strict compliance with the terms zoning ordinance, per Section 223-181, would be impractical and cause undue hardship on the petitioners.
