FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The record of this case is hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the testimony and evidence comprising the record, the Board hereby authorizes the requests, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Operation of the beauty shop shall be limited to the resident and one part-time operator.
- Three parking spaces for each station of the beauty shop, a total of 6 parking spaces shall be established on the property in accordance with the requirements of the zoning ordinance.
- 3. One business identification sign to exceed 2 square feet per side may be erected on the property in conjunction with the establishment and operation of the beauty shop. Additional signs required by the Board of Cosmetology may also be erected.
- 4. Due to the particular circumstances in this case, authorization for the establishment and operation of the beauty shop is hereby limited solely to the applicant and one part-time operator.
