## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The record of this case is hereby included by reference in this decision. Contrary to the public notice of this application, the requested use is for an agricultural barn to provide shelter for four horses. The minimum distance requirements governing location of buildings in which farm animals are kept differ from the requirements pertaining to private stables. Based on the testimony and evidence comprising the record, the Board hereby authorizes relaxation of the minimum distance requirements for use of the building as an agricultural barn, subject to the condition that not more than four horses shall be kept on the premises at one time. The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that the building was originally constructed as a private stable; and enlarged approximately seven years ago; testimony was presented indicating no adverse affects to adjoining properties resulting from use of the building as an agricultural barn for the shelter of horses; and, there is no indication that the relaxation as requested and conditioned above will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
