FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case, the Board hereby authorizes the requests, subject to the conditions noted below. The pertinent findings justifying the authorizations include the facts that operation of the contractor's equipment storage building and yard, as requested and conditioned below will not unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest. In order to promote the intent and purpose of the zoning ordinance, the Board hereby imposes the following conditions of authorizations:

- 1. As identified on the plot plan submitted with this application, the existing building and storage yard abutting the rear of the building are authorized for storage of contractor's equipment. No equipment or materials shall be stored to the sides or front of the building.
- No employee parking shall be permitted on the premises in conjunction with operation of the contractor's equipment storage building and yard.
- No identification sign is authorized in conjunction with operation of the contractor's equipment storage building and yard.

- 4. Contractor's equipment that may be stored in the building and storage yard to the rear of the building shall be limited to the following items:
 - One cement mixer
 - One water tank (55 gallon drum)
 - Scaffolding and boards
 - d. One pick-up truck
 - e. One dump truck
 - f. Concrete blocks, bricks, drain tile and similar items
