## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The pertinent findings justifying the authorization include the facts that use of the property is severely restricted by the minimum building line of fifty feet; only a portion of the proposed garage will project beyond the minimum building line; and, there is no indication that the establishment of the attached garage, as proposed, will unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
