FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

Based on the application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case, the Board hereby authorizes the conditional use and variance requests. The pertinent findings justifying the authorizations include the facts that the proposed two-family dwelling represents the best use of the property and will be beneficial to adjoining properties. As proposed, the two-family dwelling will appear to be a single-family dwelling when viewed from either the front of the property or the rear of the property. Under the circumstances, relaxation of the minimum lot width requirement of 75 feet to 70 feet is considered reasonable and appropriate to allow construction of the two-family dwelling as proposed. From the record there is no indication that establishment of the two-family dwelling as proposed would unduly affect the adjoining properties or public interest.
