FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings include the following facts.

The conditional use for the dog kennel for 20 dogs and an animal grooming service was authorized in Case 2785 on September 2, 1987. At that time the request was based on the conceptual site plan identified as Applicants' Exhibit 1. With the establishment of the kennel and grooming shop, an exterior fenced exercise area divided into runs was established adjacent to the southwesterly side of the building. The dogs are normally kept within the building, but are placed in the exterior runs for short periods of time during the day. These exterior exercise runs are not used as boarding runs. All boarding runs are located within the existing building. No additional enlargement of the building is proposed.

In considering the record of this case, the Board finds no indication that the increase in the number of dogs that may be boarded in the facility would unduly affect the adjoining properties or surrounding area.
