FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board hereby authorizes the variance. The pertinent findings determining the Board's authorization include the facts that the configuration of the property is irregular; location of the proposed dwelling on the property in compliance with the minimum required side yards would necessitate a setback of at least 300 feet, placing the proposed dwelling to the rear of the adjacent dwelling to the north--to the detriment of each property; most of the adjacent lots were recorded prior to establishment of the "C" Conservation District and have been developed with minimum side yard requirements of 20 feet; and, the Board is convinced that location of the dwelling as now proposed will not unduly affect the residents of the adjoining properties, the values of those properties, or public interests.
