## FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The application, testimony and evidence comprising the record of this case are hereby included by reference in this decision. Based on the record, the Board hereby authorizes the request. The pertinent findings determining the Board's decision include the facts that principal use of the property is a general store. Numerous products are offered for sale including groceries, nursery stock, bedding plants, pottery and garden ornaments. Changes in the operation of the business have reduced the need for the greenhouse, and have resulted in a greater need of sheltered storage space. The building will enhance the appearance of the property, which should be beneficial to the surrounding properties, without adversely affecting the public interest. The Board directs attention to the fact that erection of the building will be subject to the requirements of the Carroll County Landscape Manual, as well as all other applicable ordinances.
